Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is provided, pursuant to FCC Rule 73.3541(a), to notify the Federal Communications Commission of the recent death of the above-referenced Patsy R. Parker. The late Mrs. Parker was the sole shareholder of Parday, Inc., the corporate licensee of radio broadcast station KPTX-FM, Pecos, Texas (Facility ID: 51572). Mrs. Parker passed away on July 30, 2019. A copy of her death certificate is enclosed. As sole shareholder, Mrs. Parker was directly in control of the corporate licensee. This Notification is being provided within 30 days of Mrs. Parker's death.

With respect to this facility, an extension of time of no more than 60 days is requested for the filing of an Application on FCC Form 316 requesting the Commission's consent for an involuntary transfer of control pursuant to FCC Rule 73.3541(b). An extension of time is needed because, as the attorney for the estate has informed the undersigned, Letters of Testament ("Letters") to establish the named executor as the independent executor of Mrs. Parker's estate, with authority to act for the estate under Texas probate law, have not yet been issued by the local probate court. The undersigned has also been informed that, due to local judicial scheduling, such Letters are unlikely to be issued until some time next month, and might possibly be delayed until some time in October 2019.

Once such Letters have been issued, an Application on FCC Form 316 requesting the consent of the Commission for an involuntary transfer of control of the licensee from the deceased to the executor, with a copy of those Letters attached as an exhibit, will be promptly filed
