Dear Mr. Schober:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 13, 2019. ZIP2 requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 19, 2016, to continue ND operations to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to obtain a new license.¹ In support of the request, we noted that ZIP2 requested additional time to file an FCC Form 301 application to modify BP-20161017AAJ, which is directly related to the construction permit BP-20140721ABD for station WXPA(AM) due to an interference reduction agreement.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WKGE(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 850 kHz with 10 kW (day and night), and BP-20161017AAJ authorizes a change in frequency and the daytime pattern, along with elimination of the licensed nighttime operation.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and ZIP2 may continue ND operation using tower #5 with a maximum of 2.5 kW (day and night). ZIP2 must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See 47 CFR §1.1310.*

This authority expires on **February 29, 2020.**
