Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for a minor change to a licensed facility construction permit.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of Section 73.807 of the Commission's Rules¹ in relation to construction permit BNPFT-20190731AAZ (amended 9/6/2019) for translator station NEW, El Cajon, CA. The required separation is 32 kilometers, whereas the proposed separation is 18.7 kilometers.

LPFM modification applications must either meet the distance separation requirements or, if short spaced, not lessen the spacing to subsequent applications. The instant application reduces the spacing to BNPFT-20190731AAZ (amended 9/6/2019) from 20.2 kilometers to 18.7 kilometers.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BPL-20190909ABO is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.²
