SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION TO DENY

Press Communications, LLC ("Petitioner"), the licensee of WTHJ(FM), Bass River

Township, New Jersey, pursuant to *Amendment of Part 74 of the Commission's Rules Regarding*FM Translator Interference, Report and Order, FCC 19-440, released May 9, 2019 (the "FM

Translator Interference Report and Order"), and the letter from James D. Bradshaw, Senior

Deputy Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau, dated September 9, 2019 to John F. Garziglia,

Esq. (the "FCC Letter"), hereby submits this Supplement (this "Supplement") to its May 23,

2018 Petition to Deny (the "Petition to Deny"). This Supplement provides information

specifically requested by the Commission in the FCC Letter regarding the new FM translator

filed by Clear Communications, Inc. (the "Applicant") on FM Channel 293, 106.5 MHz, at

Vineland, New Jersey (FCC File No. BNPFT- 20180502ABQ / FCC Facility ID No. 202064)

(the "Translator Application" or the "Application"). In response to the FCC Letter, the following is submitted:

¹ This Supplement is timely filed within the 30-day time period specified in the FCC Letter.

- 1. The FCC Letter stated that, under the revised interference standards adopted in the FM Translator Interference Report and Order, additional information supporting the May 23, 2018 Petition to Deny is required. Petitioner is hereby submitting such additional information.
- 2. Attached to this Supplement is the Engineering Statement of T Z Sawyer Technical Consultants (the "Engineering Statement"). That Engineering Statement depicts the WTHJ(FM) 60 dBμ protected contour and calculates that there are 174,813 persons encompassed within that 60 dBμ protected contour (2010 U.S. Census). Thus, in accord with Table 1 to Section 74.1203 of the Commission's rules, the Minimum Number of Listener Complaints is six.
- 3. Attached to the Engineering Statement are 16 signed and dated Listener Complaints, each giving the Listener's full name, address and phone number, a clear concise and accurate description of the location where interference is alleged, a statement that the Listener listens over-the-air to WTHJ(FM) at least twice a month, and a statement that the Listener has no legal, financial, employment, or familial affiliation or relationship with WTHJ(FM).
- 4. Accompanying each Listener Complaint are maps prepared by T Z Sawyer Technical Consultants plotting the specific locations of the alleged Listeners' interference in relation to the WTHJ(FM) 45 dB μ contour, and a showing that at each specific stated location, the ratio of undesired-to-desired signal strength will exceed -20 dB μ for the co-adjacent channel relationship between WTHJ(FM) and the FM Translator. ²
- 5. Also attached is a Declaration of Richard T. Morena, the Chief Financial Officer and Member of Press Communications, LLC, the licensee of WTHJ(FM). Mr. Morena states that he has management responsibility for the overall compliance of WTHJ(FM) operations with

legal and regulatory requirements, and that WTHJ(FM) is operating within its licensed

parameters.

6. Finally, attached to this Supplement is a September 18, 2019 letter to the

Applicant, directed through its counsel of record, Melodie Virtue, Esq., in which WTHJ(FM)

uses commercially reasonable efforts to inform the FM translator applicant of the claimed

interference and attempts a private resolution of such interference. As shown in the resulting

email exchanges, it appears to be that the only resolution possible is one where the Translator

Application is amended to specify a non-adjacent channel and is granted a construction permit

for that non-adjacent channel.

7. Petitioner has fully complied with the FCC Letter's request for additional

information to support the Petition to Deny. The Translator Application is unacceptable for

filing pursuant to Section 74.1204(f) of the Commission's rules. The Application should either

be dismissed as inadvertently accepted for filing, or denied.

Engineering Statement Narrative

This engineering statement and its associated exhibits, figures and tables have been prepared on behalf of PRESS COMMUNICATIONS, LLC, (PRESS) license of full-service FM Broadcast Station WTHJ, Bass River Township, New Jersey, FCC facility ID: 49984, in support of an objection to the application of CLEAR COMMUNICATIONS, INC., for a secondary service FM Translator at Vineland, New Jersey, FCC facility ID: 202064, FCC application file number: BNPFT-20180502ABQ.

CLEAR COMMUNICATIONS, INC., proposes in its application for a NEW FM Translator to construct and operate on Channel 293D, 106.5 MHZ with a power of 0.25 kW. The proposed facility is co-channel with the existing operation of WTHJ and will cause harmful and destructive radio frequency interference to the regularly received signal of WTHJ within the extended service area of WTHJ (i.e., the 45 dBu contour), as shown in Figure 1.

In support of its regular reception service and in particular to the area located beyond the predicted 60 dBu f(50,50) service contour of WTHJ, but within its 45 dBu extended service contour, PRESS submits SIXTEEN (16) LISTENER OBJECTIONS from persons whom regular listen to WTHJ at home, at work, or while traveling between those locations within the 45 dBu contour. All are located within the WTHJ's 45 dBu contour, as shown on the individual location maps associated with each objection.

In support of the submitted objections, the following map exhibits/figures and tables have been prepared by this office.

FIGURE 1 - Determination of Interference Area:

Figure 1 is a map showing the area of predicted interference from the proposed translator that has been created using a method previously established by the Commission in 47 CFR 73.525 to determine interference areas

between TV Channel 6 (analog) facilities and reserve band NCE FM Stations. Its use here to define the predicted interference area from the FM translator proposal is appropriate in a contour to contour interference study.

The distances to all contours of concern are calculated using the antenna height above average terrain and the effective radiated power in the pertinent directions and the F(50,10) or F(50,50) field strength curves as appropriate from each facility.

The predicted interference area is then defined as the area within the protected station's 45-dBu field strength contour that is bounded by the locus of intersections of a series of field strength contours and the applicable interference contours.

For co-channel stations, the dB ratio is 20 dB; thus, the 45-dBu f(50,50) desired service contour is matched with the 25 dBu f(50,10) undesired interference contour and so forth.

The area of interference, as shown in Figure 1, is substantial at 1,898.7 square kilometers and has a population of 306,025 persons within the area (based on the 2010 US Census).

Minimum Number of Listener Objections Required:

Figure 1 also shows the predicted 60 dBu service contour from WTHJ. The 60 dBu contour contains a population of 174,813 persons. Thus, establishing the minimum number of objections to the proposed translator required as SIX.

Method used to determine field strength values:

Tables 1 and 2 are the supporting data record tables; the location information was taken directly from the listener objection forms. The home addresses or office/work locations were then converted to geographical coordinates using the functions available in Google Maps. All coordinates in the tables are in NAD83 datum.

Once the location's coordinates are known, use the various programs available on the Commission's website, to determine the distance and bearing to the point (the listener location) from each facility.² The height of the antenna above average terrain for the pertinent bearing can be found using the Commission's "Antenna Height Above Average Terrain (HAAT) Calculator." The ERP (power) of the facility (along with any directional pattern) can be found using the Commission's Mass Media engineering databases. And finally, once all of the

elements above are known, the predicted signal level can be calculated using the Commission's "FM and TV Propagation Curves." 4

The predicted signal levels from the proposal have been calculated for all locations supported by listener declarations. The proposed translator DOES NOT meet the desired to undesired signal protection ratio of 20 dB for co-channel facilities with respect to WTHJ's signal as required by the Commission's rules at these locations.⁵

The listener objections and individual maps showing that each location is within the 45 dBu contour of WTHJ follow the tables. An index is provided to each person's objection/declaration and the individual location map.

I, Timothy Z. Sawyer, have prepared the technical materials presented in this engineering statement or cause them to be prepared under my supervision and review. The statements presented herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

This letter is sent on behalf of Press Communications, LLC in accord with the new requirements imposed by the Federal Communications Commission in *Amendment of Part 74 of the Commission's Rules Regarding FM Translator Interference*, Report and Order, FCC 19-440, released May 9, 2019 (the "Report and Order"), and that certain letter from James D. Bradshaw, Senior Deputy Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau, dated September 9, 2019 (the "Letter") regarding the new FM translator for Vineland, New Jersey proposed by Clear Communications, Inc. (FCC Facility ID No. 202064 / FCC File No. BNPFT-20180502ABQ).

The FCC, in both the Report and Order and in the Letter, requires that Press Communications, LLC inform a relevant FM translator applicant of claimed interference. To the extent that our previous May 23, 2018 Petition to Deny did not so inform Clear Communications, Inc. of such claimed interference, this letter hereby notifies Clear Communications, Inc. that its new FM translator facility is predicted, due to the massive overlap of the Press Communications, LLC WTHJ(FM), Bass River Township, New Jersey 45 dBµ (F50,50) contour and the proposed Clear Communications, Inc. 25 dBµ (F50,10) contour, to cause significant interference to numerous WTHJ(FM) radio listeners. Press Communications, LLC is prepared to show such interference with the required number of listener complaints and associated materials in response to the Letter.

Nonetheless, if a private resolution of this predicted interference is possible in advance of the Press Communications, LLC response to the Letter, we welcome such a proposal. Press Communications, LLC would be amenable to a resolution in which the WTHJ(FM) 45 dBµ contour is no longer overlapped by the proposed FM translator's interfering contour. Such a resolution might occur by a change in the translator's transmitter site location, a move to another channel, a significant reduction in power, a highly-directional antenna, or a dismissal of the application.

Please let me know immediately if such a resolution is possible. Such a resolution would conserve FCC resources as well as our own.

Dear Ms. Virtue:

We have evaluated the WTHJ 45 dB μ (F50,50) contour as well as the proposed FM translator's 25 dBu (F50,10) contour. The calculated interference area within the WTHJ 45 dBu contour extends all the way from Mount Holly to just east of Vineland to Ocean City with a significant number of WTHJ listeners within that interference area. Also, as you will recall, there are a significant number of WTHJ listeners outside of the WTHJ 45 dBu contour but within the proposed 60 dBu of the translator.

WTHJ notes that, pursuant to Paragraph 44 of the FM Translator Report and Order, with a showing of 20 listeners outside of the WTHJ 45 dBu contour, a waiver request will be entertained by the FCC which would have the effect of encompassing your proposed FM translator with complainants making it highly unlikely that your client will receive a construction permit grant from the FCC with any facility no matter how minimal the parameters.

Therefore, the only resolution we can contemplate would be one where your client amends its application to a non-adjacent channel and is granted a construction permit for that channel. Please let me know if your client will be seeking to so amend its application.
