## Dear Applicant:

This is with respect to the timely petition you filed seeking reconsideration of the staff's dismissal of the above-referenced application for a digital companion channel at Las Cruces, New Mexico, filed by NPG of Texas, L.P. Because your proposed transmitter site was in close proximity to the Mexican border, the staff was required to refer the application to Mexico for international coordination and the Mexican government notified the Commission that it objected to grant of the application. On reconsideration, you submit an engineering study which you claim alleviates Mexico's interference concerns.

In view of the foregoing, your application IS HEREBY REINSTATED for further processing. You are further directed to file an amendment to your application within 15 business days from the date of this letter, containing the engineering statement attached to your petition for reconsideration.
