Dear Mr. Kitchen:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 18, 2019. Townsquare requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 2, 2014, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application due to changes caused by modifications done over the past five years.<sup>1</sup> In support of its request, we note that Townsquare will require additional time to file the application to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.



<sup>1</sup> WOBM(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1160 kHz with 5 kW day and 8.9 kW night.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Townsquare may continue to operate with parameters at variance and reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed limits. Townsquare must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 2, 2020**.
