Dear Mr. Lopez:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 7, 2020. IBC requests a further extension of the STA granted on February 27, 2019, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 applications for co-owned stations WRSJ and WQBS, due to repairs done over the past two years. In support of the request, we note that IBC will need additional time to complete repairs and file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is HEREBY GRANTED, and IBC may continue ND operation (day and night) using a maximum of 1 kW, or with DA parameters at variance and reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed tolerances. IBC must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use

whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on July 14, 2020.
