Dear Ms. Chuh:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application filed by Bonneville Holding Company (BHC) to change site and patterns, and the May 21, 2008, amendment.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that the nighttime proposal will enter the 50% RSS limit of co-channel station XEHX, CD. Obregon, Sonora, Mexico, in violation of the US/Mexican Agreement. It is noted that BHC may not use the currently licensed KMVP contribution for reference because the licensed nighttime facility was objected by the Mexican government in the late 1980's. The XEHX RSS of 13.2 mV/m consists of 10.8 mV/m from XEMO, and 7.6 mV/m from XEPLA. All questions concerning protection of Mexican stations should be directed to Mr. George Fehlner of the FCC's International Bureau at (202) 418-2197.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
