Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 16, 2020. CCBL requests an extension of the STA granted on July 22, 2019, to continue operating daytime with reduced power to allow time to file an FCC Form 301 application to make changes to the licensed facility.¹ In support of the request, CCBL states that it plans to file the application to co-locate with another existing station soon.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and CCBL may continue to operate with reduced power daytime (with no change to the licensed 10 kW critical hours directional antenna operation). CCBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's

exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 30, 2020**.
