> > Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Tillotson:

This letter concerns the request you filed on January 24, 2020, on behalf of North County Broadcasting Corp. (NCB), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station KFSD to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that NCB stated that Station KFSD(AM) went silent on June 1, 2019, for financial reasons. The previous STA was granted on July 10, 2019, and expired on January 6, 2020.¹ NCB requests extension of its STA for continuing financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

NCB's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KFSD(AM) to remain silent until June 1, 2020. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KFSD(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., June 2, 2020.²

NCB is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If NCB does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.³

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.⁴
