Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 11, 2008, on behalf of Western New Life, Inc. ("WNL"). WNL requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") originally granted on December 22, 1998, and modified on February 28, 2003, to operate Station WJZG (formerly WXZX) with the facilities specified in Construction Permit BMPH-20030116AAF, except that operation on Channel 293A is proposed, instead of Channel 254A as authorized.¹

In support of the request, WNL states that the previous STA included a condition that operation must terminate upon commencement of operation by Station WVIS on second adjacent channel 291, and that WVIS has stated that it has filed a request for Program Test Authority. WNL further states that, because the two stations would be colocated, there would be no actual interference, and that the licensee of WVIS has agreed to support WNL's request for continued STA.

Our review indicates that the complex, multiple-station channel swap authorized in MM Docket No. 91-259 has not yet occurred, and that Station WJZG continues to be precluded from operation on its authorized Channel 254A. We agree that, although the proposed STA operation would not comply with the Commission's distance separation requirements for stations operating on second adjacent channels, there would be no predicted area of interference between Stations WJZG and WVIS under the proposed operation. Under the unique circumstances presented here,

¹ WJZG is authorized (BMPH-20030116AAF) for operation on Channel 254A (98.7 MHz) with effective radiated power of 6 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 178 meters. The station currently is operating pursuant to STA with its authorized facilities, except that it is operating on Channel 293A in lieu of Channel 254A and with reduced power of 5 kilowatts.

we believe that the public interest would be served by permitting continued STA operation, provided that no actual interference occurs. STA will be granted, with conditions.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, with conditions as discussed above. Station WJZG may continue to operate with the following facilities:

WNL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. The authority granted herein is subject to immediate termination, without prior notice or right to hearing, upon receipt of complaints of interference between Station WJZG and Station WVIS (FM), Vieques, Puerto Rico, Channel 291B.

This authority expires on December 17, 2008.
