Dear Mr. Janbakhsh:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 12, 2020. TVH requests an extension of the STA granted on August 27, 2019, to continue operating ND with reduced power to allow time to install a new replacement tower and complete all other required repairs due to storm damage that occurred on August 22, 2019.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, TVH stated that additional time will be needed to sell the station to a new licensee that will install the new tower and complete the related repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and TVH may continue to operate ND with a maximum of 1.57 kW (day) and 0.375 kW (night). TVH must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio



<sup>1</sup> WTOX(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1480 kHz with 6.3 kW (day) and 1.5 kW (night), using the daytime pattern at night with reduced power.

frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. An e-mail must be submitted to my attention to note the date the required FCC Form 302 application was filed to update all operating parameters (due to the replacement of tower #1).

This authority expires on **September 8, 2020**.
