Dear Mr. House:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 26, 2020. KLL requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 25, 2018, as last updated on December 23, 2019, to continue ND operation at night with 0.4 kW to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application (due to the replacement of one collapsed nighttime tower).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, KLL stated that additional time will be needed to complete all remaining work and file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

• Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;

• Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or

• No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the STA extension request is HEREBY SUPERSEDED, and KLL may now operate ND at night using a reduced maximum power level of 0.4 kW to protect station WKRC

(ID# 29737), with no change to the daytime licensed 5 kW ND operation. KLL must reduce power or cease operations if any additional complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. KLL must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed.

This authority expires on September 22, 2020.
