Dear Mr. Tyler:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 6, 2020. TM requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 17, 2012, as modified, to operate ND using one reconstructed tower to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application (due to destruction of the original three tower array).¹ In support of the request, TM requests additional time to file the application to propose a new permanent facility.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TM may continue to operate with the following facilities:


¹ KOKC is licensed for 50 kW operation on 1520 kHz with a daytime ND antenna, and a nighttime DA antenna.

TM must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR 1.1310. TM must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed.

This authority expires on **October 8, 2020**.
