Dear Mr. Hierra:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 20, 2020. KRH requests an extension of the STA granted on September 20, 2019, to continue operating with a long wire antenna from an adjacent site location to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application due to sale of the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, KRH stated that additional time will be needed to file the application to diplex with another nearby existing AM station.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and KRH may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Hours of operation	day and night

¹ KASA(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1540 kHz with 10 kW (day) and 0.019 kW (night).

KRH must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. KRH must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed.

This authority expires on October19, 2020.
