Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 18, 2020. IHM requests a final extension of the STA granted on June 29, 2006, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters. In support of the request, we noted that IHM stated that it plans to file the application with a new proof very soon.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED and IHM may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed limits. IHM must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on October 20, 2020.

¹ WSYR(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 570 kHz with 5 kW (day and night).
