Dear Ms. Flick:

This is in reference to your letter of July 6, 2020, responding to our deficiency letter concerning the above-captioned application to cover construction permit BP-20151230APJ which authorized KKNS to move to a shared location and change to ND2-U operation.¹ The letter granted program test to KKNS but withheld license grant pending a site agreement between the four stations involved in transmission diplexing and resolution of a red light hold. Pending production of the site agreement including the prospective license assignee Navajo Nation as a party, you have requested a further 45 day extension of time for program test authority and for consideration of the pending license application. You also note that the red light hold has been resolved.

Accordingly, your request is granted. KKNS may continue to conduct program test, in accordance with Construction Permit BP-20151230APJ, and Section 73.1620 of the Commission's rules, on 1310 kHz with a daytime nominal power of 5.0 kilowatts (antenna current 8.16 amperes) and a nighttime nominal power of 0.082 kilowatts (antenna current 1.05 amperes) as shown on FCC form 302-AM.

¹ KKNS(AM) is licensed to operate with 5.0 kW DAN-U but seeks to move and collocate with three other AM stations with ND2-U operation, with 5.0 kW daytime and 0.082 kW at night.

The diplexing agreement must be provided before the license application is granted. In lieu of the agreement, the program test authority here granted will expire on **October 16, 2020**.
