Further note: Under silent station STA BLSTA-20200219AAC, granted by letter dated March 4, 2020, WJVP must return to

operation no later than **September 20, 2020** to avoid automatic license cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, or provide alternative information before that date (see Footnote 4 of that letter). Please be aware that unauthorized operations – operations with facilities not authorized by a current STA or license – do not count as a resumption of operations within one year for the purposes of Section 312(g) of the Communications Act,

and cannot be used to avoid the consequences of Section 312(g). See *A-O Broadcasting Corporation*, FCC 08-10, 23 FCC Rcd 603 (2008).

Considerations:

Licensee must take all steps to ensure that workers and the public are not exposed to radiofrequency exposure In excess of the Commission's exposure limit.

This Special Temporary Authority does not supersede any non-FCC-regulated requirements applicable to the STA-authorized facility. The licensee remains solely and wholly responsible for maintaining compliance with such requirements.

- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.
