In reply to the Audio Division's letter of July 24, 2020, regarding an interference complaint against the above-referenced FM translator, because of the current pandemic and other personal circumstances, I am unable to communicate with or otherwise to address any of the various listener complaints at this time and will not be able to do so in the near-term future.

To provide an immediate, though temporary, resolution, I took the translator off the air on August 24, 2020, at approximately 8:00 p.m. Therefore, while I neither concede the validity of any previous complaints nor claim that they are invalid, it is not possible at this time for any listener to WVLT to be experiencing any interference from W221DG.

I will file an appropriate request for authority for the translator to remain silent, and the translator will remain silent, until I am able to return to working on the interference problem.
