Dear Mr. Moran:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 9, 2020. RCI requests a further extension of the STA granted on March 13, 2020, to continue operating with a reduced daytime power of 2.5 kW to allow time to repair/replace the old 5 kW transmitter.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, RCI stated that additional time is needed before it can resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RCI may continue to operate with a reduced daytime power of 2.5 kW, with no change to the licensed nighttime 0.5 kW operation. RCI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure



guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. RCI must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-20161229AFD with negligible changes.

This authority expires on **March 23, 2021**.
