## Dear Mr. Hendrickson:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 29, 2020. FVW requests a further extension of the STA granted on August 16, 2018, to continue ND operation at the licensed site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application. In support of the request, FVW stated additional time will be needed to file the application due to the planned sale of the licensed site and the prior removal of one tower.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and FVW

may continue to operate ND daytime using the one remaining licensed tower, with a maximum of 1.25 kW (day) and 0.25 kW (night). FVW must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. FVW must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed.

This authority expires on April 5, 2021.
