Greetings.

On behalf of our clients, Rocking M Media, LLC (RMM) and its wholly owned subsidiary, Rocking M Media Wichita, LLC (RMMW), each being licensee of some of the above-referenced radio stations located in the Wichita, Kansas area, we hereby respectfully submit the response of these two licensees to the Operational Status Inquiry letter (the Letter) of the Audio Division dated September 24, 2020 (1800B3-VM) addressed to the Managing Member of both RMM and RMMW. The Letter calls for a response within 30 days of the date of the Letter, so this response is timely submitted.

Preliminarily, it is understood that the Audio Division's Letter is premised on an anonymous complaint letter dated August 3, 2020, mailed apparently on August 4, 2020, and addressed to Thomas Hutton, Esquire of the Audio Division, asserting *without any evidence whatsoever* that the stations referenced above were silent *for an unspecified period of time* without Commission authority. RMM and RMMW are of the view that the allegations in the complaint are false in some respects and misleading in others, and that the complaint letter may have been submitted by one or more individuals currently involved in civil litigation with RMM and/or RMMW in a Kansas state court, who have a distinct motive to misrepresent facts to the Commission to the detriment of RMM and/or RMMW.

Be that as it may, the circumstances involving these stations are as follows. The principals of RMM and RMMW are a single family, resident in Kansas and Colorado with a long history of competent, rule-compliant broadcast ownership and management in the State of Kansas.¹ The stations in the Wichita area are the most recently acquired stations of the group.

Two of the principals of RMM, Monte M. Miller and Doris J. Miller are each 50% stockholders of Melia Communications, Inc. Melia is the licensee of the following radio broadcast stations:

Exhibit A hereto is a copy of a Complaint and Request for Assessment of Monetary Forfeiture (Complaint) submitted to the Commission October 17, 2019 by RMM and RMMW against the former Lessor of the studio facility from which all of the stations subject to the Letter were programmed at all relevant times, until September 23, 2019. All licensed stations to which the Letter refers were on the air and operating pursuant to their respective Commission licenses, using licensed facilities and operating full time at licensed operating parameters, continuously from prior to January 1, 2019 until September 23, 2019, without exception.² However, due to debt amortization obligations, available revenue for operating expenses has been difficult with respect to the Wichita area stations, since their acquisition by RMM and RMMW. The situation for RMM and RMMW in Wichita has been exacerbated this year by the advent of the COVID-19 Pandemic, which has resulted in a *severe* reduction in operating revenues from the Wichita stations in particular, and a severe reduction in spot sales, despite receipt by RMM of a CARES Act PPP loan, and other available COVID-related assistance. The financial difficulties of RMMW and RMM with respect to the Wichita area stations continued during 2019 and to the present time.

Further complicating the issue was a failed sale of each of the Wichita area stations from RMM and RMMW to Allied Media Partners (AMP) in 2019. AMP refused to consummate the assignment of the licenses subject to the Letter. In BALH-20190403AAV, RMM had proposed to assign KWME, KLEY, KKLE, K262CQ and the K230CE construction permit to AMP. In BALH-20190403AAQ, RMMW proposed to assign KIBB, KVWF and KKGW to AMP. The Commission granted consent to both of these proposed assignments on May 30, 2019. AMP meanwhile, and since the execution of an Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement among the parties, provided programming and sales for each of these stations pursuant to a Local Marketing Agreement (LMA), during which time AMP acquired virtually all of the airtime of all of the Wichita RMM/RMMW stations. During the LMA period in 2019, RMM and RMMW employed Mr. Brian Nugen, the current operations manager for RMM in Wichita, as RMM's principal licensee representative to supervise AMP as the time broker. RMM also had, during all of 2019 and until March 31 of 2020 (when he resigned) a contract engineer, Mr. William C. Mauldin, whose charge included FCC compliance obligations, among other things. AMP refused to close on the assignment and as the result of the breach of the Asset Purchase Agreement between and among AMP and RMM and RMMW, the LMA was terminated by RMM in the Fall of 2019. The termination of the LMA and the failure of AMP to consummate the assignment necessitated restoration of programming, sales and staffing for the Wichita stations under the supervision of Mr. Nugen as Operations Manager.

Per **Exhibit A**, on and prior to September 23, 2019, each and all of the six stations referenced in the Letter and licensed to RMM and RMMW were programmed from leased studios in the Wichita area. On or about September 23, 2019, without due process of law, the Lessor of the leased studio facilities used by the subject RMMW and RMM stations took unlawful control of all³ of the radio broadcasting stations licensed to RMM and RMMW by

summarily seizing the broadcasting studios, all office records, and equipment from the building, from which and with which RMM and RMMW controlled, operated, managed and, pursuant to the AMP LMA, programmed radio stations KWME, KVWF, KIBB, KKLE, KLEY and KKGQ (as well as the K262CQ FM Translator, which rebroadcasts KLEY(AM), *while those stations were on the air* and while they were each being operated legally. The studio Lessor, that day, claiming nonpayment of rent, seized all of the equipment of the Stations which belonged to RMM and RMMW (and personalty of AMP as time broker), and the Lessor refused RMM access to the studio facilities, despite the fact that the stations controlled from that studio were transmitting at the time they were taken over by the Lessor. The Lessor has since, and to date, refused to permit RMM or its agents to recover or operate that equipment, which was critical to the operation of all of the subject radio broadcasting stations.⁴ It also refused to allow RMM or RMMW's authorized time broker for some of the Stations into the studio facilities to recover any equipment or personal items, and thus caused all of the stations to be taken off of the air thereafter by RMM. The details of this event were detailed in the RMM Complaint, **Exhibit A**. To date, on information and belief, the Commission has taken no action against the studio Lessor in response to the Complaint. Upon the eviction by the Lessor from the studio facilities, on advice of undersigned counsel, RMM and RMMW turned off all of the subject Wichita area stations because it was impossible to control the transmitters immediately after the eviction from the studios.

Following the eviction of RMM, RMMW and their LMA time broker from the studios, RMM and RMMW terminated the LMA due to nonperformance of the Asset Purchase Agreement by AMP and its failure to consummate the Commission-approved assignment of the stations. The combination of (1) the failure of the AMP transaction; (2) the resultant need to rebuild the goodwill, programming and staff for the RMM and RMMW Wichita operations; (3) the need to find alternative studio facilities for all stations; (4) the need to acquire studio equipment seized and retained by the former studio Lessor; and (5) ongoing financial difficulties of the licensee, resulted in a substantial delay in returning the stations to the air.⁵ Due to a miscommunication between communications counsel for RMM and RMMW and the RMM/RMMW facilities manager, and due to omissions by the former contract engineer for these stations, there were not during the period September 23, 2019 and early in 2020, applications for Special Temporary Authority to remain silent filed, or a notification of silent status filed with the Commission for any of the subject stations.

Since then, however, the stations have been returned to the air under varied circumstances and varied dates, detailed hereinbelow. It is notable, however, that (a) there have been no changes in the transmitter site facilities of any of the stations or their operating parameters; (b) all transmission facilities are intact in every case, albeit with some repairs required as indicated below); and (c) with the exceptions noted below, the stations in each case are either on the air now and are operating in accordance with all licensed parameters, or else they are ready to be

placed on the air with licensed facilities. The summaries below are affirmed by the Wichita Operations Manager of RMM and RMMW, Mr. Brian Nugen, in **Exhibit B** hereto.

KKGO(FM), licensed to Newton, KS was returned to the air permanently on January 6, 2020 and has been on the air continuously since that time, operating pursuant to licensed parameters. The station has been operated continuously since January 6, 2020. Attached as **Exhibit D** are photographs of the KKGQ transmitting facility including the transmitter, all of which were taken on October 13, 2020. The coordinates are as specified in the License: 38° 01' 12.00" N. Latitude and 97° 23' 05.10" W. Longitude (NAD 83). The Effective Radiated Power of the station now is and has been as specified in the license: 95 kilowatts.

KIBB(FM), licensed to Haven, KS was returned to the air permanently on February 4, 2020 and has been on the air continuously since that date, operating pursuant to licensed parameters. Attached as **Exhibit E** are photographs of the KKGQ transmitting facility including the transmitter, all of which were taken on October 13, 2020. The coordinates are as specified in the License: 37° 48' 00.70" N. Latitude and 97° 31' 30.20" W. Longitude (NAD 83). The Effective Radiated Power of the station now is and has been as specified in the license: 18.5 kilowatts.

KWME(FM), licensed to Wellington, KS was off the air during the period September 24, 2019 through February 10, 2020, during which time studio facilities for the station were being rebuilt and staff was being retained to recommence regular licensed operation. Through inadvertence of the Marketing and Facilities Manager of RMM and the omission of the same by the contract engineer, Mr. Mauldin, no silent STA application was filed. KWME was returned to the air on February 11, 2020, and was operated in accordance with licensed operating parameters through March 15, 2020, when it was taken silent again due to technical issues with the Studio-to-Transmitter link (STL). After some delay due to a shortage of operating funds, a new STL has been acquired and will be installed shortly. Again, through inadvertence, Special Temporary Authority to remain silent after March 15, 2020 was not sought by the licensee until October 13, 2020 when an application was filed for authority for KWME to remain silent. It is understood that KWME must be returned to the air on or before March 14, 2021 in order to avoid a 47 U.S.C. § 312(g) license forfeiture. Plans are being made now for the installation and relicensing of the new STL in order to return the Station to the air timely and to resume full, licensed program service. Photographs of the transmitter and antenna for KWME are attached hereto as **Exhibit F**. The coordinates are as specified in the License: 37° 20' 08.10" N. Latitude and 97° 27' 54.20" W. Longitude (NAD 83).

KVWF(FM), licensed to Augusta, KS was silent during the period September 24, 2019 through February 5, 2020 while its studio facilities were being rebuilt, while station staff was being retained, and while replacement broadband facilities were arranged to feed the signal to the licensed transmitter site. Through inadvertence of the Marketing and Facilities Manager of RMM, no silent STA was filed during this time. KVWF was returned to the air February 5, 2020, and it was operated through March 1, 2020, when the transmitter failed. A rebuilding of the transmitter or acquisition of a replacement transmitter is necessary but to date, the finances of RMM and RMMW have not permitted the expenditure. Again, through inadvertence and due in part to the resignation on March 31, 2020 of RMM's Wichita contract engineer, special temporary authority to remain silent after March 1, 2020 to the present time was not sought by

the licensee until October 14, 2020. It is understood that KVWF must be returned to the air on or before February 28, 2021 in order to avoid a 47 U.S.C. § 312(g) license forfeiture. Plans are being made now for financing and acquisition of a replacement rebuilt transmitter, or a rebuild of the current transmitter, with which to return KVWF to the air and resume full, licensed program service. Photos of the transmitter site and facilities of KVWF are attached as **Exhibit G**, showing the fault in the existing transmitter. The coordinates are as specified in the License: 37° 44' 13.00" N. Latitude and 97° 09' 26.10" W. Longitude (NAD 83).

KKLE(AM) was off the air during the period September 24, 2019 through August 11, 2020 due to lack of operating funds, and due to a severe reduction in advertising revenues due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and the economic downturn resulting from it. Through inadvertence of the Marketing and Facilities Manager of RMM and the omission of the station's former contract engineer, no silent STA was filed during this time. On advice of RMM's communications counsel, KKLE was returned to the air on August 11, 2020, and was operated through August 25, 2020, when it was taken silent again due, again, to the financial circumstances of the Licensee. Through inadvertence and due to the resignation of the station's contract engineer, Special Temporary Authority to remain silent after August 25, 2020 was not sought by the licensee until the application filed October 14, 2020. It is understood that KKLE must be returned to the air on or before August 24, 2021 in order to avoid a 47 U.S.C. § 312(g) license forfeiture. Plans are being made now for refinancing in order to return the station to the air timely. Photos of the transmitter site and facilities of KVWF are attached as **Exhibit H**. The coordinates are as specified on the license: 37° 14' 11.00" N. Latitude and 97° 01' 31.00" W. Longitude. As noted hereinabove, RMM is the permittee of FM Translator K230CE, which when fully constructed will rebroadcast KKLE. That construction permit expires January 24, 2021.

KLEY(AM) was off the air during the period September 24, 2019 through August 10, 2020, due to lack of funds to operate the station, and more recently due to a severe reduction in advertising revenues due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the economic downturn resulting from it. Through inadvertence of the Marketing and Facilities Manager of RMM and the omission of the station's former contract engineer, no Silent STA was filed during that period. On advice of RMM's communications counsel, KLEY was returned to the air on August 11, 2020, and was operated (and rebroadcast via licensed FM Translator K262CQ, Wellington, KS) through August 25, 2020, when it was taken silent again, due again to the financial circumstances of the Licensee. Again, through inadvertence, Special Temporary Authority to remain silent after August 25, 2020 was not sought by the Licensee until an application was filed on October 14, 2020. It is understood that KLEY must be returned to the air on or before August 24, 2021 in order to avoid a 47 U.S.C. §312(g) license forfeiture. Plans are being made now for refinancing in order to return the station to the air timely. The station is ready to be placed on the air. Photos of the transmitter site and facilities of KVWF are attached as **Exhibit I**. The coordinates are as specified on the license: 37° 14' 28.00" N. Latitude and 97° 24' 4.00 " W. Longitude.

The stations are now being programmed by RMM and RMMW from replacement studios now located in Wellington, KS. **Exhibit J**, attached, contains photographs of the replacement studios for all six stations. Following the resignation at the end of March, 2020 of Mr. Mauldin, the former contract engineer for RMM's Wichita stations, a replacement contract engineer, Mr.


Bart Jones, was retained part time and has made progress in addressing the technical issues noted above with respect to two of the subject radio stations.

The Audio Services Division's Letter calls for additional documentation of the operational status of the stations at issue between January 1, 2019 and the present time. That further documentation is still being assembled now by the licensees and will be submitted as a supplement to this response within the next two weeks. The task of assembling this documentation has been complicated by the unavailability of records and documents that were and are in the former studio facilities which were seized by the former lessor of that facility, as detailed in **Exhibit A** hereto.

To summarize: all stations listed in the Audio Division's Letter, and the licensed FM Translator K262CQ, were on the air at all licensed periods, operating at licensed parameters, between January 1, 2019 and September 23, 2019. All stations identified in the Letter were removed from the air, on or immediately after September 23, 2019. KKGQ(FM) and KIBB(FM) were returned to the air at licensed parameters on January 6, 2020 and February 4, 2020 respectively, and both stations have operated continuously since those dates, to the present time. KWME(FM) was returned to the air on February 11, 2020 and aired programming until March 15, 2020 when taken silent again due to issues with the station's STL. The station will be returned to the air shortly. KVWF(FM) was returned to the air on February 5, 2020 and was taken silent again due to a transmitter failure on March 1, 2020. The station has been silent since that time pending repair or replacement of the transmitter. KKLE(AM) and KLEY(AM) were each returned to the air August 11, 2020 and taken silent again due to financial issues on August 25, 2020. They have each been silent since August 25, 2020. STA applications have been filed for the four stations now silent, noting the dates that the stations most recently went silent, and requesting authority to remain silent for the periods set forth in each application. These applications are as follows: (1) for KVWF, BLSTA-20201014AAC; (2) for KWME, BLSTA-20201014AAD; (3) for KKLE, BLSTA-20201014AAF; and (4) for KLEY, BLSTA-20201014AAH.

Should further information with respect to the foregoing, or with respect to Exhibits A through J be needed (pending submission shortly of additional documentation called for by the Audio Division's Letter as soon as the assembly thereof can be completed), kindly notify the undersigned counsel.

**COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR ASSESSMENT
OF MONETARY FORFEITURE**

Comes now Rocking M Media, LLC, the licensee of, *inter alia*, radio broadcasting station KWME (FM), FCC Facility ID Number 31894, licensed to Wellington, Kansas; and Rocking M Media, Wichita, LLC, the licensee of, *inter alia*, radio broadcasting stations KIBB (FM), FCC Facility ID Number 59995, licensed to Haven, Kansas; KVWF (FM), FCC Facility ID Number 164106, licensed to Augusta, Kansas; and KKGQ (FM), FCC Facility ID Number 35020, licensed to Newton, Kansas, by and through counsel; and hereby submit this Complaint and Request for Assessment of Monetary Forfeiture (Complaint) against Envision Broadcast Network, LLC, and its “affiliate,” Envision, Inc. (the two Envision entities being hereinafter referred to as Envision). Rocking M Media, LLC and Rocking M Media Wichita, LLC, which have identical ownership, are hereinafter referred to collectively as RMM. This Complaint is filed pursuant to Section 1.41, Section 1.80(a)(2) and Section 1.80(b)(7) of the Commission’s Rules.¹ As RMM will demonstrate herein, Envision, on or about September 23, 2019, without due process of law, took unlawful control of four of the radio broadcasting stations licensed to

RMM by summarily seizing the broadcasting studios and equipment from which and with which RMM controlled, operated and programmed radio stations KWME, KVWF, KIBB and KKGQ (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Stations”), while those stations were on the air and were being operated legally. Envision seized all of the equipment of the Stations, which belonged to RMM, and refused RMM access to the studio facilities, despite the fact that the stations controlled from that studio were transmitting at the time they were taken over by Envision. Envision has since, and to date, refused to permit RMM or its agents to recover or operate that equipment, which is critical to the operation of all four of the subject radio broadcasting stations. It has also refused to allow RMM or RMM’s authorized time broker into the Station facilities, and it has caused the stations to be taken off of the air (which would not have occurred but for the unilateral actions of Envision. These actions are in violation of Sections 301 and 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended; they are with respect to KKGQ in violation of Section 73.1150 of the Commission’s Rules; and they are in violation of 18 U.S. Code § 1362. In support for its Complaint, RMM states and avers as follows:

1. RMM owns and operates radio broadcasting stations in Kansas, and it has for several years. Until September of 2017, Envision Broadcast Network, LLC was the licensee of KKGQ(FM), licensed to Newton, Kansas. On or about April 5, 2017, RMM and Envision Broadcast Network, Inc. entered into a Purchase and Sale Agreement whereby Envision Broadcast Network, Inc. would sell and assign the assets of KKGQ to RMM for specified consideration including a promissory note. Pursuant to Commission authority (See, BALH-20170414ACW) the parties consummated the assignment of the assets of KKGQ to RMM on September 22, 2017. One of the assets acquired by RMM from Envision Broadcast Network, Inc. in that transaction was a commercial office lease of the studio facilities for KKGQ located at 604

North Main Street, Wichita, Kansas. The Lessor of that lease was Envision, Inc., which is described in the lease as an “affiliate” of Envision Broadcast Network, Inc. The term of the lease was two years, and it included a holdover provision entitling RMM to hold over after the expiration of the lease for a period of time, and then for the lease to become a month-to-month lease thereafter. RMM was never in arrears in the rent provision of the lease. RMM used the premises for the studio facilities of all four of the Stations, not just KKGQ.

2. Nevertheless, on September 23, 2019 Envision changed the locks on the studio, refused to allow RMM or RMM’s then Time Broker, Allied Media Partners, to enter the studio, and despite the fact that all four Stations were operating from the studio (which Envision knew or should have known, no one on behalf of the Licensee was able to control the Stations from the studio. On that same day, on advice of RMM’s undersigned communications counsel, RMM shut down all four Stations’ transmitters and the stations were taken off the air on September 23, 2019.² To the present time, neither RMM nor its time broker has had access to the Stations’ studios to operate the Stations, or to retrieve the equipment to establish a different studio facility with which to operate the Stations.

3. By taking control of the Stations while they were operating and by precluding the licensee from access to the control facilities for the Stations, Envision has unlawfully assumed control of all four of the Stations without prior Commission consent, and it has deprived RMM

² RMM was able to put KGGQ back on the air remotely on September 28, 2019, but on October 1, 2019 at 2:05 p.m. someone unknown to RMM who had access to the studio facilities from which RMM was locked out by Envision turned off equipment inside the studio, and KKGQ fell silent again. RMM was able to put KKGQ back on the air remotely on October 5, 2019 from 2:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. to broadcast a football game, but the station was taken off air again thereafter because the facilities to broadcast other programming do not exist outside the subject studio facilities. The exercise of control over the Stations from the Envision-seized studio facilities on October 1, 2019 occurred in the following manner: at 2:05 that date, the transmitter audio dialed RMM’s engineer to tell him that it lost the signal from the studio. RMM engineers lost remote contact they had with the equipment inside the Envision building at that time, causing them to deduce that someone associated with Envision had to have turned off equipment in the studio.

of the ability to control the Stations. This is a violation of Section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, which provides as follows:

(d) Assignment and transfer of construction permit or station license. No construction permit or station license, or any rights thereunder, shall be transferred, assigned, or disposed of in any manner, voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, or by transfer of control of any corporation holding such permit or license, to any person except upon application to the Commission and upon finding by the Commission that the public interest, convenience, and necessity will be served thereby. Any such application shall be disposed of as if the proposed transferee or assignee were making application under section 308 of this title for the permit or license in question; but in acting thereon the Commission may not consider whether the public interest, convenience, and necessity might be served by the transfer, assignment, or disposal of the permit or license to a person other than the proposed transferee or assignee.

4. By forcibly taking control of the Stations while they were operating and by assuming control of the facilities of the Stations and the location from which programming was initiated while the Stations were operating to the exclusion of the licensee and its Time Broker, and by turning off the remote control equipment in the studio on October 1, 2019, Envision operated and controlled the Stations itself, without an instrument of authorization from the Commission.

Section 301 of the Communications Act forbids precisely this activity. It reads, in relevant part, as follows:

No person shall use or operate any apparatus for the transmission of energy or communications or signals by radio (a) from one place in any State, Territory, or possession of the United States or in the District of Columbia to another place in the same State, Territory, possession, or District; or (b) from any State, Territory, or possession of the United States, or from the District of Columbia to any other State, Territory, or possession of the United States; or (c) from any place in any State, Territory, or possession of the United States, or in the District of Columbia, to any place in any foreign country or to any vessel; or (d) within any State when the effects of such use extend beyond the borders of said State, or when interference is caused by such use or operation with the transmission of such energy, communications, or signals from within said State to any place beyond its borders, or from any place beyond its borders to any place within said State, or with the transmission or reception of such energy, communications, or signals from and/or to places beyond the borders of said State; or (e) upon any vessel or

aircraft of the United States (except as provided in section 303(t) of this title); or (f) upon any other mobile stations within the jurisdiction of the United States, except under and in accordance with this chapter and with a license in that behalf granted under the provisions of this chapter.

Envision did not at any time since September 23, 2019 have a license to operate or control any of the four radio stations at issue herein.

5. As discussed above, Envision was formerly, until September 22, 2017, the licensee of one of the four radio stations discussed herein, namely KKGQ(FM). Though money was due and owing to Envision from RMM with respect to the purchase money promissory note described hereinabove, Envision did not (and RMM did not permit Envision to) have any reversionary interest in KKGQ. Therefore, by unlawfully taking control of (*inter alia*) KKGQ while that Station was operating, and by taking control of the operation of KKGQ to the exclusion of RMM, Envision has violated Section 73.1120 of the Commission's Rules, which prohibits any reversionary interest of a former licensee after assignment of that license to a new licensee. By implication, that rule would have to prohibit the exercise or any claim of entitlement to a reversionary interest in a radio station that has been assigned pursuant to Commission authority.

That rule Section reads as follows:

§ 73.1150 Transferring a station.

(a) In transferring a broadcast station, the licensee may retain no right of reversion of the license, no right to reassignment of the license in the future, and may not reserve the right to use the facilities of the station for any period whatsoever.

6. Finally, Envision's actions constitute a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1362, which defines as a felony the willful or malicious injury of property, or material of any radio, telegraph, telephone or cable, line, station, or system, or other means of communication, operated or controlled by the United States, and the willful or malicious interference in any way with the working or use of

any such line, or system, or the willful or malicious obstruction, hindrance, or delay in the transmission of any communication over any such line, or system, or attempts or conspiracies to do such an act.

7. For all of the foregoing reasons, Rocking M Media, LLC and Rocking M Media Wichita, LLC hereby respectfully request that the Commission determine that the acts complained of by Envision were wrongful and violated the referenced statutory and regulatory obligations that Envision had and has; that it be instructed to cease and desist its exercise of unauthorized control over the operation of the subject radio broadcasting stations; and that the Commission assess a meaningful monetary forfeiture against Envision for each and every day that these violations occurred, as a deterrent to future similar unlawful behavior by Envision. RMM also requests that the Commission refer to the Justice Department for prosecution the violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1362 alleged herein.

ROCKING MEDIA

I, Brian Nugen, do hereby state and affirm under penalty of perjury, as follows. I understand that this document is being submitted to the Federal Communications Commission in response to an FCC inquiry as to the operating status of certain of the radio stations licensed to Rocking M Media, LLC and Rocking M Media Wichita, LLC.

My name is Brian Nugen. I serve as the current Operations Manager for KIBB-FM, KKGQ-FM, KVWF-FM, KWME-FM, KLEY-AM and KKLE-AM. I have been working for Rocking M Media since 2010. On Jan. 1, 2019 I was the Operations Manager for Wichita, and Co-Manager of our Wellington Stations.

When Rocking M Media began the sale of the stations to Allied Media Partners on April 1, of 2019, I was designated as the LMA employee. While serving as the LMA/Operations Manager for Rocking M Media while Allied Media Partners was programming the stations, I was responsible for overseeing the On-Air Department, Performed certain On-Air duties, coordinated with the Engineering department, and made sure that the stations operated within FCC parameters and guidelines, and reported any deviation from those rules to our Engineering department and RMM upper management. I also worked with the Engineering team to make sure that the stations maintained compliance with current FCC rules.

On September 23 of 2019 we were locked out of our studios by the property landlord, we were unable to access our studios, and the equipment and documents contained therein. As we had lost control of our control point, I was instructed to power down our stations until further notice. The sale of the stations to Allied Media Partners did not go through, and at that time, my Role as the Operations Manager changed, as I no longer had any On-Air responsibilities. I continue to monitor stations to ensure FCC compliance, and notify the Engineering team of any issues. In January of 2020, Rocking M contracted with Sun Broadcast Group to deliver music to our stations under my supervision.

KKGQ was turned back on, on a long term basis, on January 6 of 2020, and it has been back on the air since that point, airing programming supplied from Sun Broadcasting Group. It has conducted required EAS tests.

KIBB-FM was turned back on, on February 4, 2020 and has been on the air since that point to the present time, airing programming provided under contract with Sun Broadcasting Group. It has conducted required EAS tests.

Work was done to return KVWF to the air, and while the station was turned back on and provided programming periodically between February 5, 2020 and March 1, 2020, technical issues with the transmitter and internet service delivery have prevented it from being able to resume regular programming on a long-term basis.

Work was done to return KLEY and KKLE to the air permanently. However, there remain minor technical issues and, I understand, financial issues with respect to each AM station which have prevented those stations from being returned to the air permanently. Both stations were turned on and provided programming during the period August 11, 2020 through August 25, and then both were powered back off.

KWME was turned back on after new studios were constructed and staff retained, on a long term basis on February 10th of 2020. KWME aired programming supplied by Sun Broadcast Group, and required EAS broadcasts were aired until an issue arose in March with the STL system. The station was turned off due to technical issues, on March 15th of 2020. Work is ongoing now to fix the STL system.
