Dear Mr. Smith:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 14, 2020. EBL requests a further extension of the STA granted on March 29, 2019, to continue operating from an alternate site with a long wire antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application.¹ In support of the request, EBL stated that additional time is needed to file the application to build a new facility (or co-locate with an existing station).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and ELB may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Frequency	1220 kHz

¹ KLBB(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1220 kHz with 5 kW (day) and 0.25 kW (night).

Hours of operation	day and night
Operating power	0.020 kW
Antenna type	70 foot (21 meters) long-wire antenna

ELB must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 3, 2021**.
