



IN PARTICULAR, THE EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE OF THE ASSIGNEE IS OUTLINED IN ARTICLE 3 OF ASSIGNEE'S ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, WHICH AUTHORIZES ASSIGNEE TO OPERATE NONCOMMERCIAL EDUCATIONAL BROADCASTING STATION(S) AND TO PROVIDE AN EDUCATIONAL BROADCASTING SERVICE DESIGNED TO SERVE CIVIC AND COMMUNITY

NEEDS WITHIN THE BROADCAST COVERAGE AREA. THIS SERVICE WILL INCLUDE EDUCATIONAL, CULTURAL, RELIGIOUS AND PUBLIC INTEREST PROGRAMMING.

ACCORDINGLY, THE ASSIGNEE'S ACQUISITION OF THE STATION IS CONSISTENT WITH THE COMMISSION'S RULES REGARDING MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP AND NONCOMMERCIAL EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.
