This is in reference to the request filed on October 29, 2020. PRPBC requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 28, 1998, to continue ND operation using one of the WKAQ(AM) towers pending further action on the minor change application BP-20200811AAQ ¹ In support of the request, we noted that the application to relocate to the WSKN transmitter site remains under review at this time.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WIPR (940 kHz) is licensed for DA operation with 10 kW (unlimited hours), and BP-20200811AAQ proposes to colocate with WSKN using a new ND day and night antenna system with reduced power.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and PRPBC may continue to operate ND using one of the existing WKAQ towers with a maximum of 2.5 kW (day and night). PRPBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. .

This authority expires on May 17, 2021.
