This STA filing was submitted December 8, 2020 as an extension request for BSTA-20200218ABL, which had expired August 19, 2020. The 3 ½ months gap between the expiration date and the filing of this STA request for reduced power prevents consideration as an extension request. This will be treated as a new request for STA, however if does not retroactively cover any operations during the period between August 19, 2020 and December 8, 2020.

For the reasons provided in the application request, Special Temporary Authority IS GRANTED for continued operation of the station above at reduced power, as needed. The licensee must notify the Commission when licensed operation resumes. See 47 CFR Section 73.1560(d).

This STA authority expires **June 12, 2021**.

Any further STA extension request must be filed by the expiration date of the current STA.

Considerations:

This Special Temporary Authority does not supersede any non-FCC-regulated requirements applicable to the STA-authorized facility. The licensee remains solely and wholly responsible for maintaining compliance with such requirements.

Requests for extension of STA may be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Reduced power STA requests, [or extensions thereof](#), are filed as “Engineering STA”, NOT “Legal STA”. Incorrect filing results in delays in processing.
