Dear Mr. Lopez:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 29, 2021. ABC requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 29, 2017, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 applications for co-owned stations WRSJ and WQBS (due to replacement of one collapsed and all other needed repairs). In support of the request, we noted that ABC will require additional time to conduct the proof and submit the applications to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for an extension of the STA is HEREBY GRANTED, and ABC may continue ND operation (day and night) using a maximum of 1.25 kW, or with DA parameters at variance and reduced power to maintain monitor points within licensed tolerances. ABC must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use

whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on August 8, 2021.
