This STA request was filed as a request for extension of BSTA-20200514AAL. However, that STA expired November 14, 2020. That four month gap is too long for this filing to be considered a valid extension request. Instead, we will treat this as a new STA request (changing the file number prefix to BSTA-) using the technical parameters in the earlier request.

For the reasons provided in the application request, Special Temporary Authority IS GRANTED for operation of the station above with the parameters specified in the STA request only. The licensee is responsible for addressing any complaints of interference that may arise.

This STA authority expires **September 13, 2021**. It does not cover any operations that occurred between November 15, 2020 and March 15, 2021.

We remind the licensee that we expect STA extension requests to be filed on (or a few days before) the expiration date of the current STA, otherwise operations under the earlier STA are expected to cease.

Considerations:

Licensee must take all steps to ensure that workers and the public are not exposed to radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure limit.

This Special Temporary Authority does not supersede any non-FCC-regulated requirements applicable to the STA-authorized facility. The licensee remains solely and wholly responsible for maintaining compliance with such requirements.

Requests for extension of STA may be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.
