RE: WWCU(FM), Dillsboro, NC Facility ID No. 184618 Silent since January 31, 2021 Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Hartzell:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 8, 2021, on behalf of Western Carolina University (WCU), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Radio Station WWCU to remain silent.

WCU's request states that Station WWCU(FM) went silent on January 31, 2021, because it lost its programming source.

WCU's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WWCU(FM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WWCU(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., February 1, 2022.¹

WCU is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If WCU does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
