Dear Mr. House:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 28, 2021. KLL requests a final extension of the STA granted on July 25, 2018, to continue ND operation at night with 0.4 kW to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application (due to the replacement of one collapsed tower). In support of the request, KLL stated that it plans to file the application within the next few months, after completing all remaining repairs and tests.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the STA extension is HEREBY granted, and KLL may continue to operate ND at night using a reduced maximum power level of 0.4 kW to protect station WKRC (ID# 29737), with no change to the daytime licensed 5 kW ND operation. KLL must reduce power or cease operations if any additional complaints of interference are received, and use whatever

means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. KLL must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to update all operating parameters.

This authority expires on October 28, 2021.
