Request to Electronically Reissue the WVTS Station License


Dear Mr. Nguyen:

In January of this year, Bristol Broadcasting Company, Inc., filed a 302 application (see File # BP-20210119AAA) for WBES(AM) at Charleston, West Virginia, seeking to operate the station utilizing the same antenna tower as co-owned WVTS(AM) via a duplexing network. While reviewing the WBES application, Joseph Szczesny of the Commission's Audio Division discovered that there were discrepancies between the paper version of the WVTS(AM) license and a later issued electronic version of the WVTS(AM) license. Specifically, he found that the "1999 paper version of the license matches the AM engineering database records, but sometime over the past 22 years an *incorrect* electronic version of that license was created inside CDBS."

Since the WBES(AM) application is requesting that both WBES and WVTS use the same tower, it is important that no errors are carried forward on the WVTS license after further action has been taken on the WBES application. Accordingly, **we hereby request that the Commission electronically reissue the last WVTS(AM) license to include all the correct engineering parameter information from the old 1999 paper license.**
