Dear Mr. Denning:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 14, 2021. CLL requests a final extension of the STA granted on October 15, 2019, to continue operating during daytime hours only to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CLL stated that additional time will be needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CLL may continue to operate daytime only using the licensed daytime site 7 kW facility, with no



<sup>1</sup> WVNN(AM) is licensed for operation on 770 kHz with 7 kW day (ND) and 0.25 kW night (DA), at different sites, and BP-20210216AAM authorizes a correction of the daytime site coordinates, and elimination of the nighttime site facility.

nighttime operation. CLL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. CLL must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed so that we may update our records to show this STA is no longer needed.

This authority expires on **November 25, 2021**.
