Dear Mr. Hensley:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 29, 2021. NBM requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 2, 1999, as last modified on January 8, 2020, to continue temporary ND operation at an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application (due to loss of the licensed site).¹ In support of the request, we noted that NBM did not file the application over the past six months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is HEREBY GRANTED, and NBM may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates 40° 11' 20" N, 85° 23' 44" W (NAD 1927)

¹ WRFM is licensed for DA operation on 990 kHz with 0.25 kW day and 0.001 kW night.

Frequency	990 kHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	0.065 kW (Day), 0.001 kW (Night)
Antenna type	254 foot long-wire antenna

NBM must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 19, 2022**.
