Dear Mr. Fernandez:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 2, 2021. INV requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 14, 2019, to continue operating ND with reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters. In support of the request, INV stated that all repairs have been completed, with the exception of the 20 kW daytime transmitter.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is HEREBY GRANTED, and INV may continue to operate ND with a maximum of 2.5 kW (daytime) and 0.0075 kW (nighttime), or with DA parameters at variance using a reduced 12 kW daytime power level, and 0.003 kW at night, while maintaining all monitor points within licensed limits. INV must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. INV must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the

WRJR(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 670 kHz with 20 kW (day) and 0.003 kW (night), using the same pattern.

application was filed, or to note the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-20040526ATG with negligible changes.

This authority expires on February 10, 2022.
