VCY seeks to change the status of WLUV(AM) from commercial to non-commercial educational, contingent upon grant of the referenced application and consummation of the transaction contemplated therein. No technical changes to WLUV(AM) are requested. Nonetheless, at the request of staff, VCY has completed the technical questions in Section III of the Form 302-AM. To do so, VCY relied upon information in the Commission's databases and the Application for Direct Measurement of Power filed by the station's current licensee and attached hereto.

#### **NCE Certification**

VCY is a non-stock, not-for-profit corporation organized for the purpose of providing educational, religious, and family programming to audiences in the United States. VCY's educational objectives include providing religious instruction and moral teaching; offering solutions to community problems such as teenage pregnancy, drug and alcohol abuse, and crime; and helping troubled youth find meaningful and productive lifestyles. Additionally, VCY uses its programming to teach citizenship, patriotism, peaceful conflict resolution and religious principles.

VCY will offer a wide variety of educational programming designed to meet the needs of interests of residents within the local community of license, including programs examining religious, economic, and social issues.

### APPLICATION FOR DIRECT MEASUREMENT OF POWER

The following engineering statement and attached exhibits have been prepared for **Susan S. Buckwalter** ("Buckwalter"), licensee of AM broadcast station WLUV at Loves Park, Illinois, and are in support of her application for direct measurement of power.<sup>1</sup> This application is being filed following repairs to the folded unipole feed system and an associated minor change in the antenna impedance.

WLUV is authorized to operate on a frequency of 1520 kHz with a daytime nominal power of 0.500 kW, and a nighttime nominal power of 12 Watts. The licensed radiator electrical height is 163 degrees. The efficiency of the antenna is nominally 360.7 mV/m/kW at one kilometer, but has been restricted by the Commission to 317.04 mV/m/kW at one kilometer. As a result, the antenna input power has been adjusted to 0.386 kW daytime, and 0.0097 kW nighttime. These values round to 0.39 and 0.01 kW respectively. It should be noted that the nominal power values assigned to WLUV of 0.5 kW daytime and 0.012 kW nighttime, have been entered into section 1 on page 4 of the attached engineering section of FCC Form 302-AM. The antenna current values entered into section 8, "operating constants", reflect the restricted power values.

WLUV operates with a folded unipole feed system. As such, this is considered a shunt feed. Instability in the operation was observed, leading to the discovery of damage to the skirt. The skirt connections and components were cleaned, and repaired, as necessary. The attachment point to the tower was adjusted slightly in order to bring the resistance component of the

impedance back as close as possible to the licensed resistance of 60 ohms. As the measured data indicate, the antenna resistance is set at 61 ohms.

Attached to this engineering, following exhibit E-1, is a sweep of the antenna impedance. This sweep was performed at the carrier frequency and at 5 kHz increments either side of the carrier out to 30 kHz from carrier. The impedance was measured using an Array Solutions Power AIM-120 network analyzer. The reactance values listed both on the form page and on the graph do not require correction.

Preceding the sweep of the antenna impedance is Exhibit E-1. This exhibit is a vertical sketch of the tower, including the skirt, as well as the antenna for co-located FM translator station W287BY at Rockford, Illinois.<sup>2</sup> The tower is grounded, thus the transmission line for W287BY is directly bonded to the tower. No additional isolation circuits are required. The tower comprising the antenna system for WLUV has been registered with the Commission, and is assigned 1019526 as its Antenna Structure Registration Number.

Buckwalter will continue to coordinate with all other users of the site to ensure that workers and other personnel having access to the tower are not exposed to levels of radiofrequency radiation in excess of the applicable safety standards. Coordination activities will include, but are not necessarily limited to, a reduction in transmitter power or cessation of operation.
