I noted that Jerry's attached STA expired on 8/8/21, but I didn't see an internal note to verify that your client already confirmed that they were able to resume licensed ops per the last license (BMML-20130718AHZ) with negligible changes ,after the ground system was replaced.

As a result, unless you can confirm that point via a brief e-mail response, you will need to assist your client in filing an STA extension in CDBS before the end of this week to allow the station to continue operating using the attached STA params.
