Dear Mr. Mazursky:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 28, 2021. MRP requests a further extension of the STA granted on August 27, 2019, to continue ND operation with reduced power to allow time to install the new replacement tower and file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters. In support of the request, we noted that MRP plans to install the new tower in the upcoming months in order to move forward towards restoring licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is HEREBY GRANTED, and MRP may continue to operate ND with a maximum of 1.57 kW (day) and 0.375 kW (night). MRP must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. MRP must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to allow our staff to determine if any further STA operation with temporary parameters will be required.

¹ WTOX(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1480 kHz with 6.3 kW (day) and 1.5 kW (night), using the daytime pattern at night with reduced power.

This authority expires on April 14, 2022.
