Dear Mr. Parrish:

This letter concerns your request, filed on April 7, 2008, on behalf of Radio Assist Ministry, Inc. ("RAM"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W224BT to remain silent.

RAM's request states that W224BT went silent on February 5, 2008, due to termination of rebroadcast agreement. RAM further states that efforts are being made to establish a new source of programming. RAM's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

RAM's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit FM Translator Station W224BT to remain silent for a period not to exceed February 5, 2009. Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for W224BT will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. February 6, 2009. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

²Notification of resumption of broadcast operations must be mailed to:

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
