Dear Mr. Chang:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 20, 2021. JMK requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 9, 2019, to continue ND operation along with co-located station WURA to allow time to install two new replacement towers and file the required FCC Form 302 applications.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, JMK states that it plans to install the new towers in the near future.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and JMK may continue to operate ND with a maximum of 1.25 kW (day) and 0.125 kW (night). JMK must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. JMK must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the 302 application was filed to update all operating parameters (due to the tower replacements).

This authority expires on **April 24, 2022**.
