Dear Mr. Frisch:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 1, 2021. Matador requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 11, 2019, to continue operating with a long wire antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application due to loss of the licensed site in 2018. In support of the request, we noted that Matador will need additional time to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and Matador may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates 32° 02′ 22″ N, 88° 43′ 49″ W (NAD 1927)

Frequency 1500 kHz Hours of operation Daytime only

Operating power 0.1 kW

Antenna type 164 foo long-wire antenna, suspended 16 feet above ground

Matador must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. .
