Dear Mr. Curtis:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 19, 2021. CMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on March 16, 2021, to continue operating with reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to cover BP-20210204AAJ. In support of the request, CMG stated that additional time will be needed to file the application after removing four of the five existing towers.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CMG may continue to operate with the day and night directional antenna patterns using a reduced power of 5 kW. CMG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. CMG must submit an e-mail to my attention to verify the date the

application was filed to confirm no further STA operation will be needed.

This authority expires on May 15, 2022.
