Dear Ms. Herrera:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 28, 2021. KRH requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 20, 2019, to continue operating with a long wire antenna from an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application to collocate with two other stations. In support of the request, KRH stated that additional time will be needed for its consulting engineer to prepare and file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and KRH may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates 33° 22′ 33″ N, 112° 05′ 17″ W (NAD 1927)

Frequency 1540 kHz
Hours of operation day and night

Operating power 0.255 kW (day), 0.007 kW (night)

Antenna type 30.5 m long-wire antenna

KRH must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use

whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. KRH must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed to allow our staff to determine how much additional time will be allowed for temporary operations.

This authority expires on May 17, 2022.
