Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Trent:

This letter concerns the request you filed on August 9, 2021, on behalf of T O V Group Inc (TOV), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WTKE to remain silent.

TOV's request states that Station WTKE(AM) went silent on August 1, 2021, because it lost its programming source.

TOV's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WTKE(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WTKE(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., August 2, 2022.¹

TOV is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If TOV does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
