Dear Mr. Garcia:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 16, 2021. EB requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on May 20, 2021, to continue operating ND with reduced power due to copper theft that has made the directional antenna system unusable.¹ In support of the request, EB stated that additional time will be needed to complete all required repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and EB may continue to operate ND using tower #2 of the array with a reduced power of 0.625 kW, day and night. EB must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. An FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters must be filed after all repairs have been completed. Otherwise an e-mail must be submitted to my attention to verify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-19820602AH with negligible changes to all parameters.

This authority expires on **May 29, 2022**.
